An Ordinance authorizing the creation of one (1) Assistant Employment and Training Specialist (0607) position and one (1) Community Services Aide I (7450) position for a limited term effective February 8, 1982 through September 30, 1982, to staff a special youth training project within the Human Resources Bureau, Training and Employment Division (AU 682); authorizing expenditures in the amount of \$22,000 within the CETA Title IV-A funds and authorizing the drawing and delivery of a warrant and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland is the designated Prime Sponsor for administering funds under the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act (CETA) within the City, to provide training to economically disadvantaged persons.
- 2. The Training and Employment Division identified a need for a pre-employment training and job sampling project for youth and has been negotiating a contract with a community based organization to operate the project.
- 3. On January 25, 1982, TED was notified by the community based organization that it was no longer interested in providing the training.
- 4. TED elected to operate the program itself requiring that two (2) staff positions, one Assistant Employment and Training Specialist (0607) and one Community Services Aide I (7450), be created in order to provide the training which has commenced as scheduled on February 8, 1982.
- 5. The positions to be created have been classified by and have the approval of Civil Service.
- 6. TED currently has a vacant Assistant Employment and Training Specialist (0607) position which will also be utilized to support staffing for this project.
- 7. Funding previously identified for this project, covering salaries and benefits for these positions, is available through CETA Title IV-A, Youth Employment and Training Program funds.
- 8. It is therefore appropriate that one Assistant Employment and Training Specialist (0607) and one Community Services Aide I (7450) position be created for a limited term.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. One (1) limited term Assistant Employment and Training Specialist (0607) position and one (1) limited term Community Services Aide I (7450) position are created within the Human Resources Bureau, AU 682, Training

and Employment Division, effective February 8, 1982, at the salary rate in accordance with the current compensation plan of the City of Portland.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists, because delay in the enactment of the Ordinance will result in constraints being placed on the Human Resources Bureau, Training and Employment Division; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
