ORDINANCE NO. 152928

An Ordinance transferring appropriations within the Sewage Disposal Fund in the amount of \$48,100 and within the General Fund in the amounts of \$10,260 from the General Operating Contingency and \$48,100 from Unforeseen Reimbursable Expenditures; increasing appropriations in the Bureau of Street and Structural Engineering in the amount of \$58,360 for microfilming and indexing street and sewer records; and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. That the new Central Permit Application Center (CPAC) will begin operation in July 1982, and its function is to provide information and assistance to the public regarding permits issued by the City.
- 2. That in order for the CPAC to function, certain Public Works files and records should be microfilmed and indexed for use by Bureau of Street and Structural Engineering personnel assigned to the CPAC.
- 3. The microfilming and indexing of Public Works records will be compatible with and will not duplicate the Bureau of Buildings microfilming project.
- 4. That this microfilming and indexing system will be done in three phases. Phase I, which consists of microfilming and indexing sewer connection records, will be completed prior to July 1982 at a cost of \$58,360. Phase II, which consists of microfilming and indexing street Ordinances, sidewalk and driveway permit records, and other street permit information, will be done in FY 1982-83 at an estimated cost of \$9,259. Funding for Phase II has been requested in the Bureau of Street and Structural Engineering's FY 1982-83 budget request. Phase III, which consists of microfilming and indexing utility permit records, will be done in FY 1983-84 at an estimated cost of \$15,000.
- 5. As Phase I of this project will microfilm sewer connection records, it is appropriate that funds for implementing Phase I be transferred within the Sewage Disposal Fund and within the General Fund in the amount of \$58,360 and for appropriations to be increased in the Bureau of Street and Structural Engineering in the amount of \$58,360.
- 6. Implementation of the entire project will allow the Bureau of Street and Structural Engineering to reduce its full-time personnel requirements by one position beginning July 1, 1982, resulting in annual savings of approximately \$27,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The FY 1981-82 City budget is hereby amended to transfer appropriations as follows:
