ASSIGNMENT OF LEASE

3. The City expressly approves this assignment and releases Assignor from all further liability under said lease.

5. All rent and other charges owing City under said lease are paid through February, 1982. All sums owned by Assignor to City under said lease have been paid in full, and all covenants to be performed by Assignor under said lease have been performed or their performance is hereby waived.

6. It is agreed that the expiration date of said lease pursuant to paragraph 1(A) thereof is February 28, 1987.

 Assignee has inspected the premises and accepts them "as is".

8. The permitted use of the premises pursuant to paragraph 3 of said lease shall be display and retail sales of micro computers and related hardware. Assignee shall do business under the name "Computer-land of Multnomah County."

ORDINANCE No. 1. 50014

An Ordinance authorizing an assignment of the lease agreement with Martin W. Dodge and A. Raymond Dodge, individuals, to Terry Ashton, an individual, for space in Morrison Park East for the remaining term of six years, for operation of a retail store, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Portland Development Commission entered into a lease agreement with Martin W. Dodge and A. Raymond Dodge on October 31, 1980, effective February 15, 1981.
