show and petition your Honorable Body, as follows:-

We understand that a license for the sale of liquor
in what is known as the Leven's Grill has been refused, it
being claimed that said grill is not conducted in a proper
manner. This claim we disagree with, for we are all patrons
of said grill; many of us since the place was first established
and at no time have we seen or heard anything in or about the
said place which would in any way substantiate the claims
that the place is improper or has been improperly conducted.
Many of us are intimately acquainted with Mrs. Levens, and
were so with her husband, and know that they invested a very
large sum of money which would be practically lost if a license
is not obtained.

As law abiding citizens we hold the opinion that
if the license were granted and any of the laws or ordinances
were violated, you would still have the power to revoke the

the owners of the establishment an opportunity to continue
business and save their investment.
