Under the law, you are required to promptly notify FPDR by written statement if your pension payments are no longer subject to Oregon personal income tax or are once again subject to Oregon personal income tax.

If you are required to file an Oregon personal income tax return for the year after the year in which you submitted this form and your pension payments are subject to Oregon personal income tax, you are eligible for the additional tax offset benefit. Otherwise, you are ineligible. If you have any questions about your eligibility, please consult your tax advisor.
