


Homeownership Asset Preservation Program (HAPP): Accomplishments: January 1 - June 30, 2022

- 5 estate planning educational webinars provided
 - 40 households attended
- 10 program participants enrolled
 - > 5 currently receiving or have completed legal services

10 New Homeowners Served between 1/1/2022 and 6/30/2022






Homeownership Goal

Preference Policy Homeownership update


105 households towards the goal

300 individual names on current waitlist

- Phase 1 & Phase 2
- 9 units unassigned and available
- Units available for folks on the preference list

Challenges
