

ORDINANCE NO. **24264**.....

An Ordinance making it unlawful for any person to smoke in or on any street railway car in the City of Portland, Oregon, providing a penalty for violations thereof and declaring an emergency.

THE CITY OF PORTLAND DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: From and after the approval of this ordinance it shall be unlawful for any person to smoke in or on any street railway car, or on the vestibule or platform thereof, in the City of Portland, Oregon.

Section 2: Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof in the Municipal Court be punished by a fine of not more than \$50.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail for not more than five days.

Section 3: Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland, in this: That there is no ordinance in the City of Portland regulating smoking on street cars, therefore an emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
