










- PASCA has identified businesses in Portland & Israel that are working in 3 strategic technological industries



Origins of the Portland-Khabarovsk sister city relationship



The initial foundation of the official Portland-Khabarovsk sister city relationship developed over a five-year period (1983-1988) during the Cold War as part of the Portland-headquartered Ground Zero Pairing Project, which sought to establish non-political, citizen-to-citizen diplomacy between U.S. and Soviet cities.

PKSCA: Looking Towards the Future

As Russia starts regaining a steady foothold on the world stage following the eventual end of the war in Ukraine, it will need its international sister city ties more than ever before.



War or peace, rain or shine, the Portland-Khabarovsk Sister City Association will continue to uphold its 34-year old mission of fostering non-political, people-to-people connections through cultural, educational, and economic ties; and the cultivation of cross-cultural friendships.



The Portland City Council approved the Portland-Mutare Sister City relationship December 18, 1991 and as a non-profit organization, PMSCA has worked to promote good will and the exchange of ideas, goods, culture and friendship between the people of Portland, Oregon and Mutare, Zimbabwe. We strive to learn from our differences, celebrate our similarities and nurture our interconnectedness.

Since 1991, citizens from Portland and Mutare have made trips back and forth, learning from and working with each other. Our group has sent computers, partially covered teacher salaries, mailed 1200 eyeglasses, built a clinic, funded 2 ambulances, helped fund a car for rural hospice health outreach, funded a mother's shelter, clothing, textbooks, toys, school supplies, generators, musical instruments, sports uniforms, phones, heaters, radios, school fees, plus so much more. Recently, we agreed to fund bed pans and wheelchairs for hospice patients and funding for materials that deaf students will use to make and sell feminine products.








- Mutare has been a Portland Sister City for 31 years with a humanitarian focus on supporting health and education programs.

- founded in 1608 as a Society of Jesus (Jesuit) school Population
- 717,000 (2021 estimate)
- 900,000 (April 2022 estimate, with internally displaced refugees)
 US Embassy was located in Lviv from February 15 to May 18, 2022
