Please adopt the entire Floodplain Resilience Plan to protect the Portland community from whatever impacts of climate change and extreme weather events possible. Clearly protecting water quality and wildlife habitat is essential for our continued coexistence. I ask this because it is both inconsistent and irresponsible not to adequately protect our floodplains (see Pakistan, Puerto Rico, and Vanport).
