The duration of the Fellowship includes the Institute in addition to one week unpaid time off for the full week that includes December 25th. This winter break week does not count toward the 1024 hours of the Fellow's placement.

Additionally, Fellows are eligible for sick leave per PSU policy, currently at an accrual rate of 1 hour of sick leave per 30 hours worked.

Fellow Standard Position Description

Hatfield Resident Fellows are expected to work independently and with CITY on a wide range of initiatives and shall provide advanced knowledge and skills. The work assignments are strictly limited to professional level duties. Fellows shall perform professional level and specialized work that may include: conducting assessments; writing policy reports and briefs; performing analysis; conducting procedural studies; handling technical planning. Work shall be performed under the supervision of PSU, and Fellows will work on-site at the sponsor agency. Fellows are expected to meet the quality and productivity goals established by the sponsor agency in this SOW and are expected to participate in professional development and networking activities provided by PSU.

Exhibit B Hatfield Resident Fellows Program

Overview:

- Highly competitive 1024-hour commitment (frequently scheduled as 32 hours a week for 32-weeks)
 - Fellows submit a resume, writing sample(s), letters of reference and complete an interview
- Fellows receive a total amount of \$25,000 paid in salaried wages over the course of the Fellowship. Fellows are placed with state and local agencies, and nonprofits generally located in Oregon
- Fellows attend an Institute at PSU at the beginning of the Fellowship and a series of prescheduled monthly, half-day professional development programs throughout the program
- All Fellows will attend continuing education and networking events throughout the program

Agreement Mechanism and Consideration:

Sponsor Agency

- Provide a Statement of Work (see Exhibit A) that describes project objectives, deliverables, and acceptance criteria;
- Sign an agreement which is reviewed/approved by PSU's Contracts Office; and
- Provide an amount of \$43,000 per Hatfield Fellow.
 - This sum covers expenses related to program administration such as the recruitment and placement of the Fellows, the Institute provided for the Fellows, and payment of the Fellow's salaried wages.

Hatfield Resident Fellows

Each Fellow signs a Wage Agreement and completes the PSU new hire HR process.

Fellow for 1024 hours of work. In addition to the Sponsor Fee, Sponsors are responsible for
customary work-related costs, including phone and computer access, workspace, office supplies,
materials and other expenses needed for the successful completion of defined tasks.

Payment Schedule Example (per Fellow)

An initial payment in the amount of \$14,000 for each Fellow will be due at the end of the month in which the Fellow begins work.

A second payment in the amount of \$8,400 for each Fellow will be due three months following the start of the Fellowship.

A third payment in the amount of \$12,200 for each Fellow will be due six months following the start of the Fellowship.

A fourth and final payment in the amount of \$8,400 for each Fellow will be upon completion of the Fellowship.

Payment shall be made to PSU within thirty (30) days of receipt of invoice.
