Project Proposals

1. Remove minimum parking requirements citywide
2. Update and simplify parking maximums
3. Add new development standards for large parking lots





Amendment to Proposed Draft

- Move the standard from the parking chapter (33.266) back to the elderly/disabled housing chapter (33.229)
- Closes loophole for lower bike parking allowance for elderly and disabled housing

Six Steps to a Motion

1. A member raises hand, is recognized, and makes a motion
2. Another member seconds the motion
3. The presiding officer restates the motion to the commission (if unclear)
4. The members debate the motion
5. Presiding officer asks clerk to call the roll
6. The presiding officer announces the result of the voting and introduces the next item of business
