EXTRACT SECT. 16-1702 (1), ORDINANCE #76339: A PERMIT FOR SOUND AMPLIFYING DEVICE TO BE USED UPON THE STREETS OF THE CITY OF PORTLAND MAY BE GRANTED BY THE BUREAU OF POLICE UPON APPLICATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE CHIEF THEREOF, AND THE SAID BUREAU SHALL HAVE EXCLUSIVE JURISDICTION OVER THE ROUTING OF SUCH SOUND AMPLIFYING VEHICLE, AND SUCH VEHICLE SHALL IN MO EVENT BE PERMITTED TO OPERATE WITHIN TWO HUNDRED FEET OF ANY HOSPITAL, OR WITHIN TWO HUNDRED FEET OF ANY PUBLIC OR PRIVATE ELEMENTARY OR SECONDARY SCHOOL, OR ANY COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY. THE PERMIT AS GRANTED BY THE BUREAU OF POLICE SHALL IN ADDITION TO SPECIFYING THE ROUTE GENERALLY, OR SPECIFICALLY, AFFIRMATIVELY PROVIDE FOR THE HOURS DURING WHICH SUCH USE OF THE STREET MAY BE PERMITTED, AND SHALL PROVIDE THAT IN NO EVENT SHALL THE SOUND EMANATING FROM ANY SOUND AMPLIFYING VEHICLE SE AUDIBLE FOR A DISTANCE OF MORE THAN ONE SHUPPRED FEET FROM THE SAID VEHICLE.
