NOTE: PPCOA specifies Internal Affairs while PPA broadly refers to "investigation." In theory this even precludes IPR investigation.

Prior to being interviewed regarding an IAD or EEO investigation for any reason which could lead to disciplinary action.

NOTE: PPA talks about "any administrative investigation" but PPCOA only talks about Internal Affairs and Equal Employment Opportunity investigations.

PPA 61.2.2.4:

The member being interviewed shall be informed of the person directing the member to participate in an administrative investigation and/or investigatory meeting, the name of the investigator, and all other persons present during the interview.

PPCOA 29C3:

The commanding officer being interviewed shall be informed of the name, rank, and command of the member in charge of the investigation, the interviewing member, and all other persons present during the interview.

NOTE: The PPA contract broadly talks about who conducts the investigation but PPCOA assumes it is a member of the Police Bureau.

We look forward to a discussion of how to correct these problem areas.
