

## NEW GARBAGE DAY REMINDERS

**Have you ever woken up in a panic realizing you forgot to set out your waste bins the night before? Or taken all your bins to the curb because you couldn't remember which were getting picked up?**

Join the 35,000+ Portlanders that get day-before reminders and you'll never miss a pickup or scramble to get your bins out in time. Whether you rent or own your home, or live in a house, duplex, triplex, or fourplex, these reminders are for you.

In addition to email, you can now get reminders by app, text, and phone call. Want to sign up for multiple reminders? Please do! Would others in your home benefit from a reminder? Encourage them to sign up!

In the weekly reminders, you'll also hear about recycling drop-off events and quick tips to clear up recycling confusion.

### Download the app

Get notifications about which bins to set out and find answers to the most common garbage and recycling questions, all in one place:

- Look up an item to see if it can be recycled or donated, and where the nearest drop-off locations are.
- Contact your garbage company to ask about your bill, report a missed pickup, or schedule a large-item pickup.
- Play the Recycle or Not game to test your recycling knowledge.

1. Go to [www.portland.gov/garbage/day](http://www.portland.gov/garbage/day)
2. Enter your street address.
3. Click on [Get a reminder!](#)
4. Choose email, phone call, or text message.
5. Enter your email or phone number and the time you want to receive your reminder.

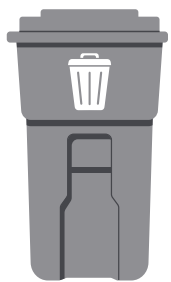

## Pickup frequency



Garbage is picked up **every other week**.

Customers with every-four-week pickup indicated with an asterisk.



Recycling, glass, and compost are picked up **weekly**.

## Service guidelines and delays

- **Set bins at the curb before 6 a.m.** Bring them back to your house within 24 hours.
- **Holiday delays:** Christmas and New Year's Day (marked with a "X" on the above calendar) are the only days garbage companies don't pick up. Collection will be delayed by one day on these weeks.
- **Weather delays:** In case of ice, snow, or wildfire smoke, collection may be delayed. Leave bins at the curb and they will be emptied as soon as it's safe to do so.
- **Early pickup on hot days:** On days where temperatures are expected to be 95 degrees or higher, garbage collection may start before 6 a.m. Set bins at the curb the night before.

## Garbage



Plastic bags, plastic lids & plastic-padded mailers. Wires, hoses, chains & electric cords. Disposable gloves & masks.



To-go containers, cutlery, cups, lids & straws (paper, plastic & "compostable"). Frozen food boxes.



Bag all pet waste, cat litter, diapers, ashes, sawdust & broken glass. Put fats, oils & grease in sealed container.



**No TVs, computers, batteries, paint, pesticides, flammables**



## Recycle



Plastic bottles & jars with a neck (6 oz or larger) & buckets (5 gal or smaller). Plastic round containers (6 oz or larger) & plant pots (4" or larger). All empty & dry.



Metal food cans (aluminum, tin & steel), paint & aerosol cans, all empty & dry. Scrap metal under 30" & 30 lbs.



Flattened cardboard. Paper, magazines & catalogs. Milk, juice & soup cartons, all empty & dry.



**No plastic bags, wrap or lids, glass, coffee cups, to-go containers**



## Compost



Meat, cheese, seafood, bones & eggshells. Bread, pasta, grains, nuts, beans, fruit, vegetables & coffee grounds. Spoiled food & plate scrapings.



Weeds, leaves, grass, flowers, house plants, plant clippings, pumpkins. Branches under 4" thick & 36" long.



Food-soiled napkins & paper towels. Paper coffee filters & tea bags. Pizza delivery boxes.



**No pet waste, dirt, rocks, ashes, lumber, to-go containers**



## Glass



Put in glass-only bin. Glass food & beverage bottles & jars. All empty & dry.



All colors of glass. Remove lids, caps & corks. OK to leave labels on.



Redeem deposit bottles at BottleDrop Centers or recycle at the curb.



**No lids, ceramics, bulbs, broken glass**

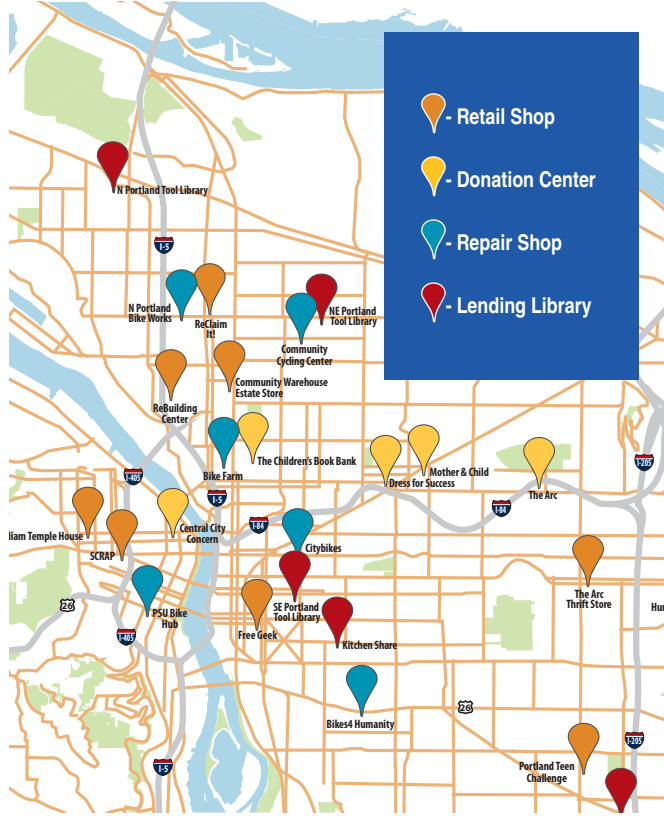
## Where to share, repair & donate

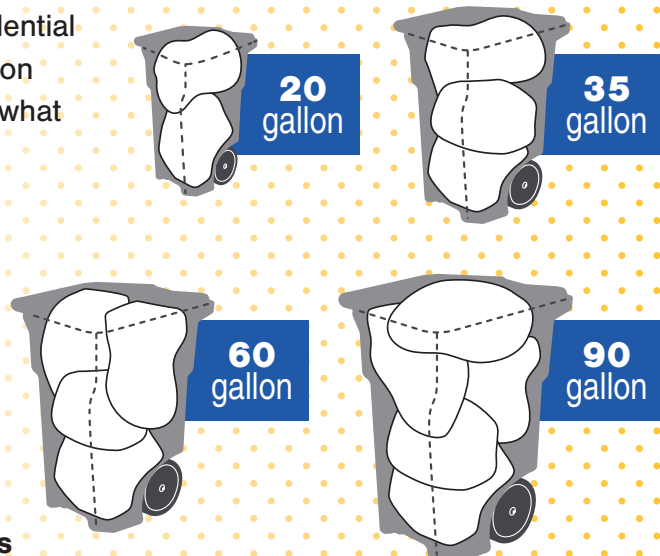

## Garbage Rates and Options

Every year the City of Portland sets residential garbage, recycling, and compost collection rates based on a thorough evaluation of what it costs to provide these services.

Your monthly waste collection charge is based on the size of your garbage bin. To change your garbage bin size, contact your garbage company. You can choose the size that best fits your needs.
