Resolution

Resolved that his Honor the Mayor
be and is hereby authorized to
contract; on the part of the City,
with the owners of the Park blocks,
lying between Stark & Salmon streets,
for the purchase of the same
in fee simple, at the rate of
\$3000.⁰⁰ each, payable in Bonds
of the City of Portland running ten
years with interest at 8% per
Annum payable semi annually.

to the Church's Addition, and the

can be obtained is about \$138,000 -
