

An Ordinance providing for the improvement of the Park Blocks in John St Couch's addition to the City of Portland

The City of Portland does ordain as follows

- Sec 1st The proposed improvement of the Public Parks lying between B Street and A Street shall consist of fencing and planting of ornamental and shade trees, and shall be completed prior before the 1st day of April next.
- Sec 2. The proposed fence shall be constructed of Cedar posts firmly set ^{ten feet apart} and extending at least two & a half feet below the surface of the ground and four feet above the established grade of the Blocks; and shall be connected by two rails two by four inches in dimension; the size of the posts and general finish of the fence shall be such as shall be adopted by the Committee on Streets & Public Property.
- Sec 3. The proposed fence shall be painted in a good and substantial manner and of such color as shall be

approved by the Comtee on Streets and Public Property.

Sec 4th The Shade and ornamental trees before mentioned shall consist of the varieties and shall be placed at such distances as shall be directed by the Committee on Streets & Public Property, and shall be planted on or before the 1st day of April next.

Sec 5. The Committee on Streets & Public Property, are hereby authorized to advertise for and enter into contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the faithful performance of the before mentioned work.

Sec 6. The improvement herein specified shall be completed under the supervision and to the satisfaction of the Committee on Streets & Public Property.
