I think that upzoning Inner Eastside to allow building of neighborhood apartments with corner stores would only amplify the positive aspects of neighborhoods like Buckman, while at the same time ameliorating the issues it has with homelessness. I'm afraid that unless the city takes measures to create more affordable housing in Inner Southeast, it will continue to get less diverse and more expensive.
