My name is Michael Harrison

I'm speaking on behalf of Portland's bicycling demographic. The e-bike industry is growing. It's projected to reach \$118 Billion by 2030 according to Allied Market Research. We are only going to see more e-bikes and bicycles on our streets here in Portland.

Although I appreciate the minimal bicycle pathways we have, we really need to look into elevated bicycle infrastructure. Elevated meaning physically placed above the ground or conventional car traffic grid. I have an unofficial signed petition with 500 signatures I have collected that I'm delivering in support of a bicycle skyway system. These signatures were collected at the PSU farmer's market last summer. Generally speaking, the public seems to like the idea of a raised bicycle platform from what I can tell at my petition signing events. Similar infrastructure already exists elsewhere around the world.

There is more to transportation than simply providing funding for extensions to the MAX or our bus system. We should not get too comfortable with our conventional transportation system. There are far too many problems associated with gasoline. As Americans, we waste about \$5,000 per year on gas, and we don't need any exploding oil rigs for e-bikes or a bicycle skyway system.

2 { There is a lot we can do to research this kind of infrastructure. I would like to see the city request a preliminary study in conjunction with an engineering firm or discuss this with ODOT.

1 { There are a few locations in the Portland Metropolitan Area that can use this kind of infrastructure which in this case extends for several miles. It can have off ramps leading to schools, universities, shopping centers and corporate work locations as well as to multiple public parks in residential areas. It can increase commercial retail traffic if the off-ramps are nearby.

Car sales are decreasing overall, meanwhile E-bike sales are increasing. With costs rising (for example, car payments, gas, insurance and repairs) e-bikes and bicycles are much more affordable for the average consumer and a bicycle skyway system helps promote that. With elevated bicycle infrastructure there is no more wasting money on gas or car insurance. It equates out to more cash in the pockets of the average consumer.

Top 11 reasons for a bicycle skyway system

1. No more wasting money on gas or car insurance

As Americans we waste about \$5,000 per year on gas

2. We can travel to school or work or do our food shopping through the use of a bicycle skyway system and bypass the conventional car traffic grid

3. We have to ask ourselves, "How much longer will the gasoline last?"

A bicycle skyway system operates completely free from the oil industry (no exploding oil rigs needed for e-bikes or bicycle infrastructure)

4. Can increase commercial retail traffic if the off-ramps are near local businesses

5. Engineering weight advantage as this infrastructure supports e-bikes and bicycles (not cars.) The infrastructure itself can be routed nearly anywhere, not only over streets, but empty land-space, rivers, water and even over trees.

6. No more 50mph car traffic whizzing past bicyclists elbows. Much safer transportation system since it is completely separate.

7. Reduces traffic congestion (incentive for more people to use e-bikes) especially for a growing population and city.

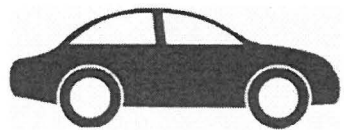
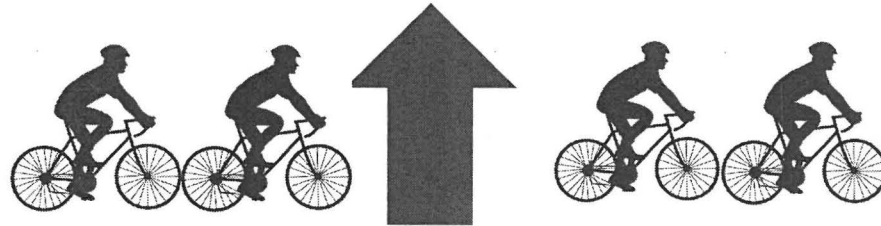
8. E-bike/bicycle usage reduces carbon emissions

9. Wonderful for personal health, more exercise

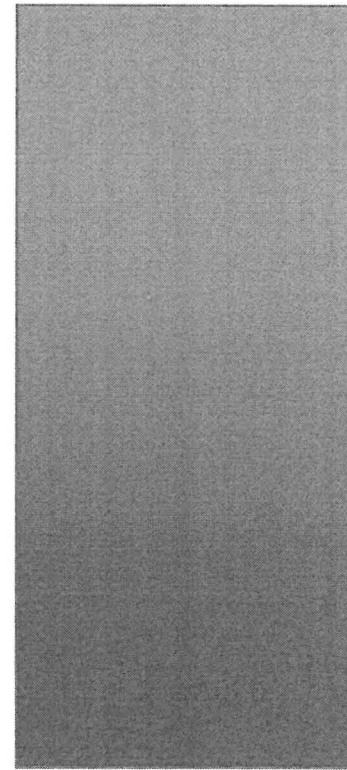
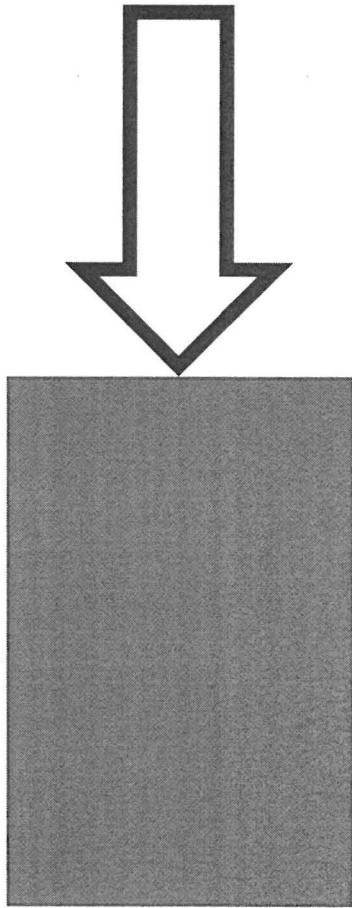
10. With costs rising overall (car payments, gas, insurance and repairs) e-bikes and bicycles are much more affordable for the average consumer

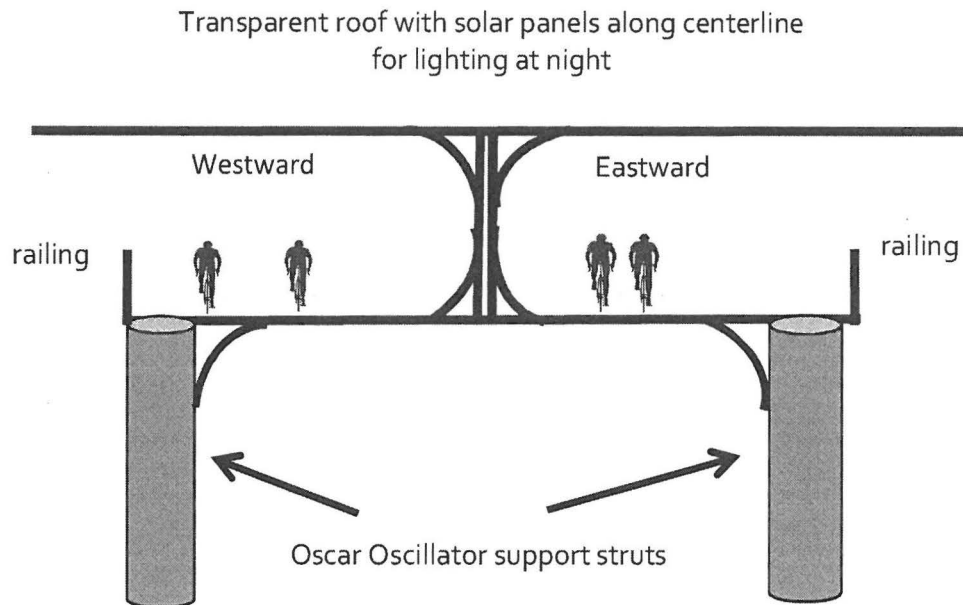

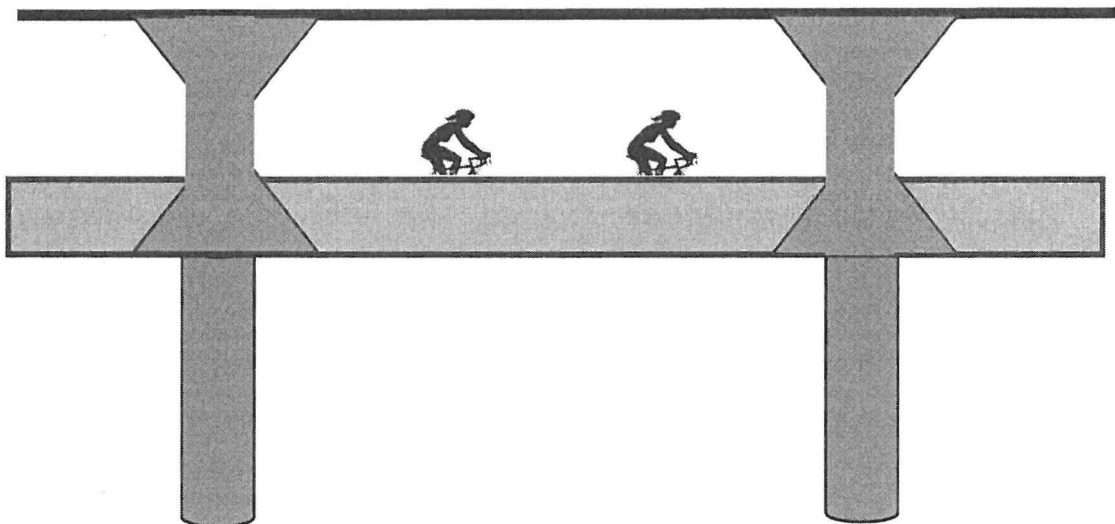

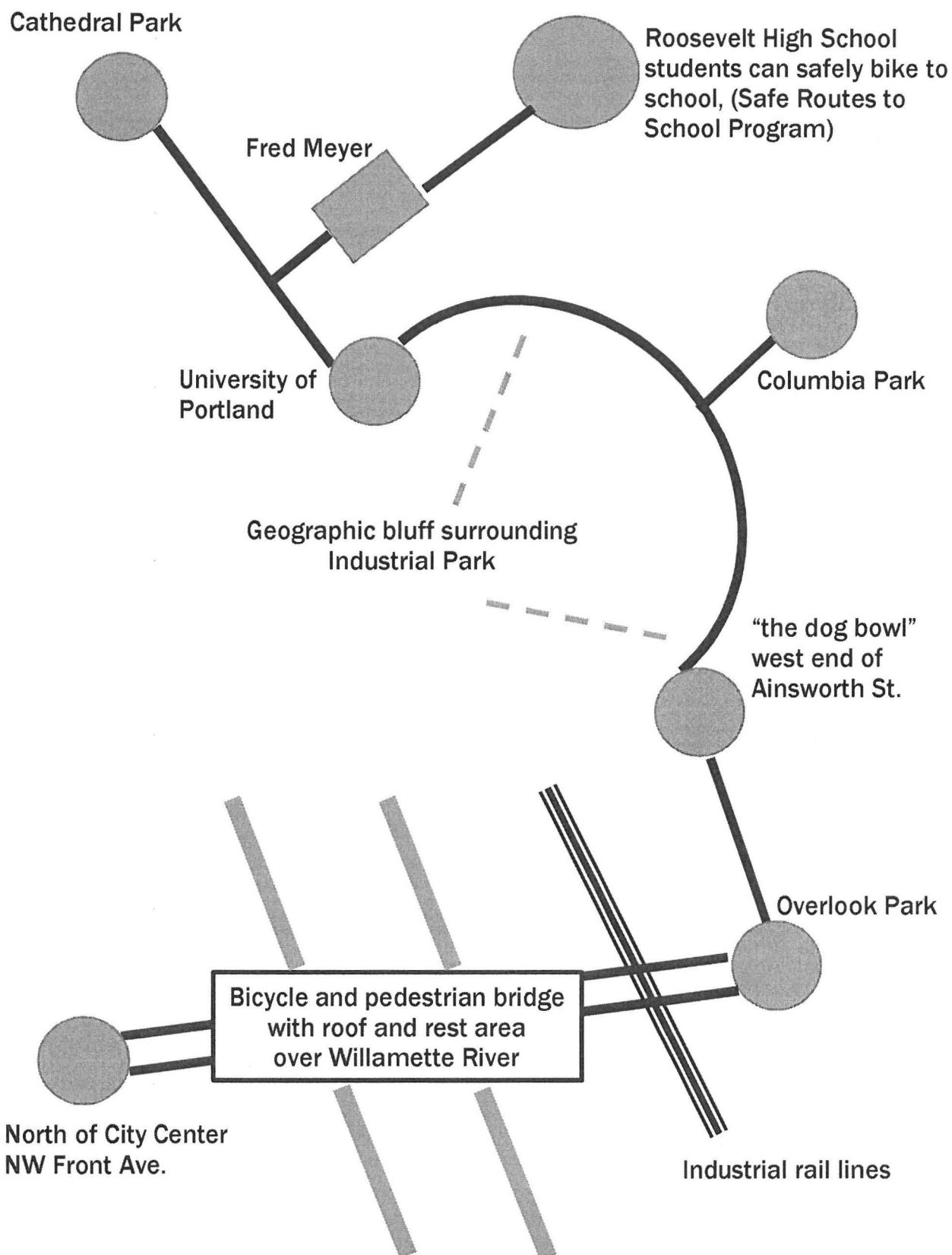
*transparent roof is mandatory (preferably with solar panels) It rains fairly often in Portland.

*The bicycle skyway needs to be big (over-sized) to accommodate a growing bicycle demographic

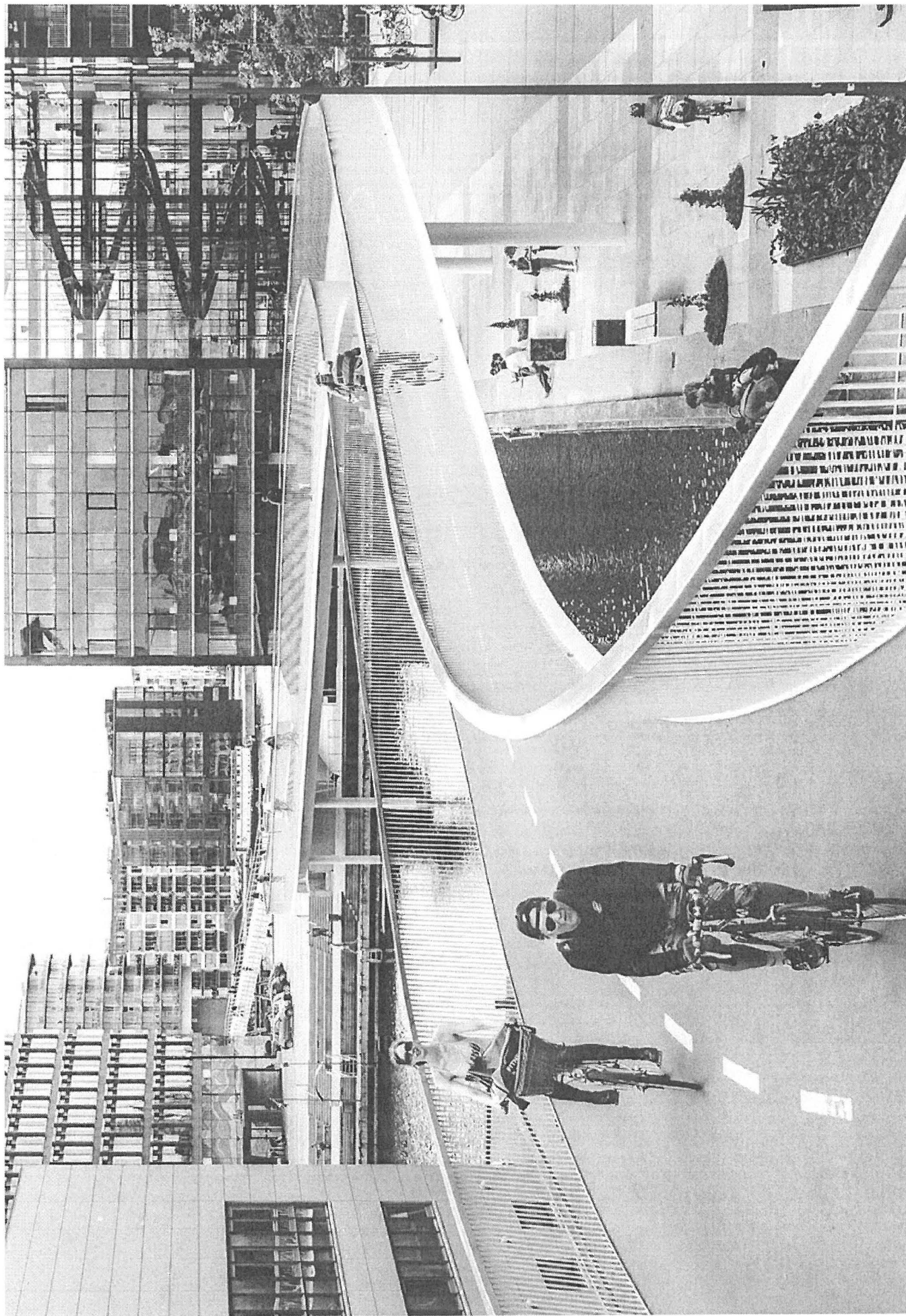
Example route in North Portland

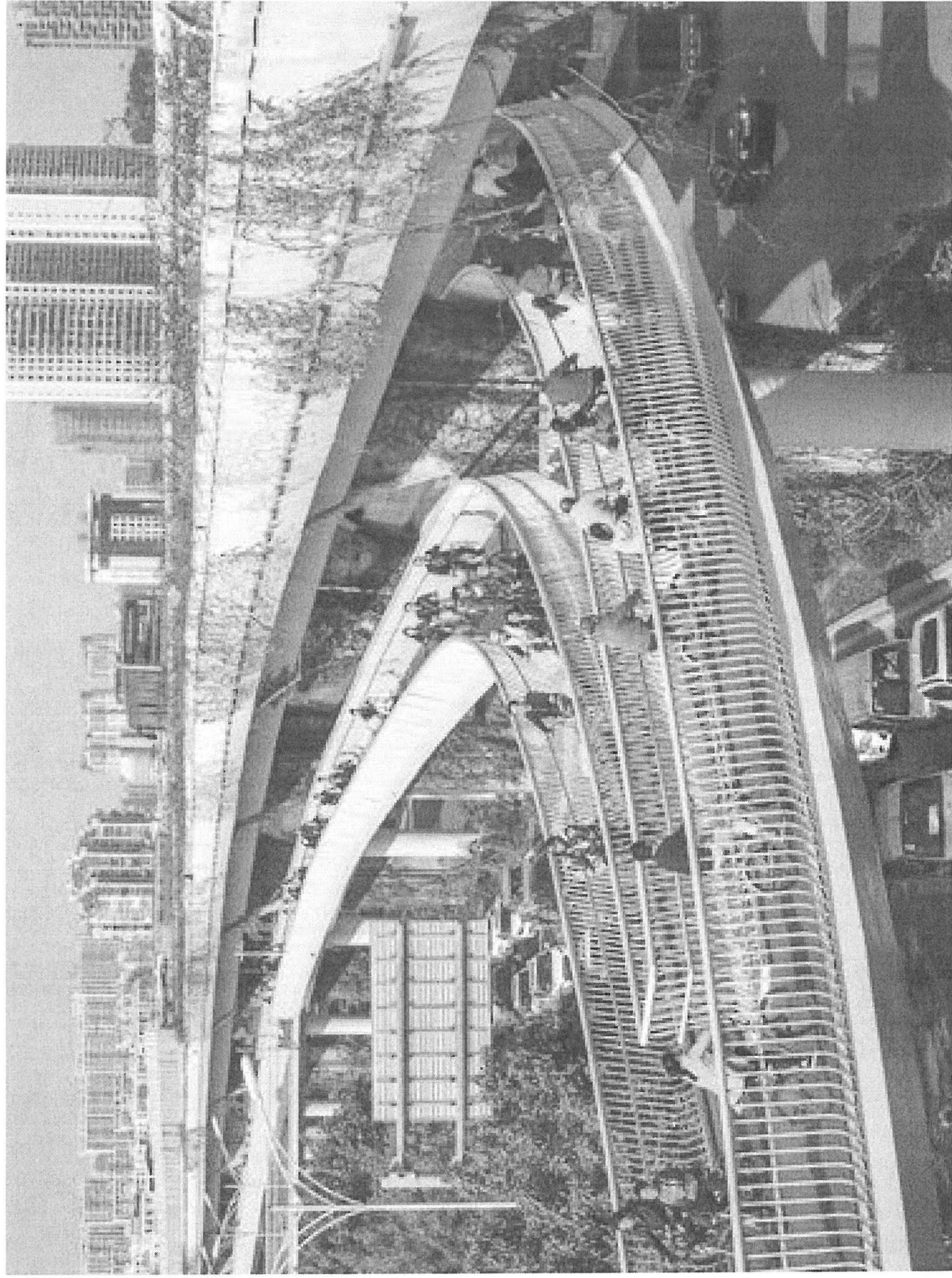











Scale model of example bicycle skyway with railing and transparent roof










