


Ordinance No. 113289 passed by the Council March 16, 1961, grants a revocable permit for the Portland Chamber of Commerce for an auto sports park in West Delta Park.

Condition No. 8 in Section 1 of this ordinance concerns the 15% service charge which the Jaycees shall pay the City. This condition should be reworded for clarification and it is recommended that the Ordinance be amended as soon as possible to do this. A suggested rewording follows:

8. The Jaycees shall pay to the City as a service charge and for expenses of the Bureau of Parks resulting from the granting of this permit, 15% of its annual gross income from the facility, except income from the sale of concession items as set forth in subparagraph a, b and c of paragraph 3 hereof. Such payment shall be made to the City not later than March 31 of each year on gross income for the preceding calendar year or portion thereof."

The original ordinance was prepared by Phil Abraham in the City Attorney's office, and the preparation of the amendment should be referred to him.

ORDINANCE No. 113353

An Ordinance amending paragraph 8 of Section 1 of Ordinance No. 113289, which granted a revocable permit to the Portland Junior Chamber of Commerce for the use of West Delta Park, so as to clarify the provisions relating to payment of service charge due the City, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Council finds that Ordinance No. 113289 granted a revocable permit to the Portland Junior Chamber of Commerce to design, construct and operate an auto sports park to be located on City Park Bureau property at West Delta Park; that paragraph 8 of Section 1 of said ordinance provided for the payment of 15% of the annual gross income from the facility as a service charge; that paragraph 8 should be reworded so as to clarify the intention of the parties involved; now, therefore, paragraph 8 of Section 1 of Ordinance No. 113289, passed by the Council March 16, 1961, hereby is amended to read as follows:

8. The Jaycees shall pay to the City as a service charge and for expenses of the Bureau of Parks resulting from the granting of this permit, 15% of its annual gross income from the facility, except income from the sale of concession items as set forth in subparagraphs a, b and c of paragraph 3 hereof. Such payment shall be made to the City not later than March 31 of each year on gross income for the preceding calendar year or portion thereof.


Section 2. This ordinance shall not become effective until permittee (Portland Junior Chamber of Commerce) has filed with the City Auditor a document in form approved by the City Attorney, accepting the terms of this ordinance.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the city of Portland in this: in order that the recently granted permit referred to in Section 1 hereof may be amended without delay, therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
