AMENDMENT NUMBER 01 LOCAL AGENCY CERTIFICATION PROGRAM Supplemental Project Agreement No. 33097 Brentwood Darlington bike/ped improvements

This is Amendment No. 01 to the Agreement between the **State of Oregon**, acting by and through its Department of Transportation, hereinafter referred to as "State," or "ODOT," and the **CITY OF PORTLAND**, acting by and through its elected officials, hereinafter referred to as "Agency," entered into on March 20, 2019.

It has now been determined by State and Agency that the Agreement referenced above shall be amended to update funding and the State and Agency contacts.

Effective Date. This Amendment shall become effective on the date it is fully executed and approved as required by applicable law.

1. Amendment to Agreement.

2. The total Project cost is estimated at \$6,201,000, which is subject to change. Federal funds for this Project shall be limited to \$2,200,000. Agency shall be responsible for all remaining costs, including any non-participating costs, all costs in excess of the federal or state funds, and the 10.27 percent match for all eligible costs. Any unused federal or state funds obligated to this Project will not be paid out by the State, and will not be available for use by Agency for this Agreement or any other projects. "Total Project Cost" means the estimated cost to complete the entire Project, and includes any federal funds, state funds, local matching funds, and any other funds. Agency will report the final cost of each phase of the Project at the completion of each phase, as well as the Total Project Cost at the end of the Project, to the State's Regional Local Agency Liaison.

Shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

2. The total Project cost is estimated at \$6,206,422, which is subject to change.

Federal funds for this Project shall be limited to \$2,159,999.40. Agency shall be responsible for all remaining costs, including any non-participating costs, all costs in excess of the federal or state funds, and the 10.27 percent match for all eligible costs. Any unused federal or state funds obligated to this Project will not be paid out by the State, and will not be available for use by Agency for this Agreement or any other projects. "Total Project Cost" means the estimated cost to complete the entire Project, and includes any federal funds, state funds, local matching funds, and any other funds. Agency will report the final cost of each phase of the Project at the completion of each phase, as well as the Total Project Cost at the end of the Project, to the State's Regional Local Agency Liaison.

TERMS OF AGREEMENT, Paragraph 36, Page 9, which reads:

- 3. <u>Original Agreement</u>. Except as expressly amended above, all other terms and conditions of the original Agreement are still in full force and effect. Agency certifies that the representations, warranties and certifications in the original Agreement are true and correct as of the effective date of this Amendment and with the same effect as though made at the time of this Amendment.

THE PARTIES, by execution of this Agreement, hereby acknowledge that their signing representatives have read this Agreement, understand it, and agree to be bound by its terms and conditions.
