ORDINANCE No. 101010

An Ordinance to amend Subsections (b) and (d) of Ordinance No. 100594 relating to a children's day nursery at 2200 N.E. 52nd Avenue so as to authorize 40 children and changing the requirements for toilets and wash bowls, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Council finds that on June 17, 1954, Ordinance No. 100594 was passed whereby Eileen M. and H. G. Jensen were granted a permit to construct, maintain and operate a children's day nursery at 2200 N. E. 52nd Avenue. The Council finds that in the development of plans for the said use, it has been found that sufficient floor space and plumbing for 40 children has been provided; now, therefore, Subsection (d) of Section 1 of Ordinance No. 100594, entitled: "An Ordinance granting a permit to Eileen M. and H. G. Jensen, husband and wife, to construct, maintain and operate a children's day nursery on N. E. 52nd Avenue between N. E. Thompson Street and N. E. Tillamook Street, under certain terms and conditions, and declaring an emergency", passed by the Council June 17, 1954, hereby is amended to read as follows:

(d) Not more than <u>forty (40)</u> children shall be accomodated at any one time in the day nursery for which this permit is granted.

Section 2. The Council finds that the provisions contained in Ordinance No. 100594 provides for 3 junior sized toilets and 3 wash bowls and 1 standard size toilet facility and wash bowl to be installed and with the increase in the permitted occupancy this should be increased to 4 junior sized toilets and wash bowls; now, therefore, Subsection (b) of Section 1 of Ordinance No. 100594 hereby is amended to read as follows:

(b) Four junior size toilets and four wash bowls installed at convenient height for small children shall be maintained, and in addition there shall be maintained one standard size toilet facility and wash bowl for attendants and other adults, and the facility provided for the attendants and other adults shall be maintained in a separate room or portion thereof and shall be completely enclosed.

ORDINANCE No. 101010

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that authority may exist coincident with the construction of the day nursery premises; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
