

 - We exceeded our 30% DMWESB goals (32%)
- Art installed
- 54% leased up (34 units leased, 23 moved in)
 - Should be fully leased by end of November
- Naming dedication was today
- Small commercial space is leased











Resident Demographics

Of the 23 head of households currently moved in:

- 91% of head of households identify as Black/African American (21 of 23 head of households)
 - 4 of the 21 Black/African American head of households identify as mixedrace
- 4.3% (1 head of household) identify as white
- 4.3% (1 head of household) declined to report

Of the 40 total residents that have moved in:

- 95% of residents identify as Black/African American (38 of 40 residents)
 - 8 of the 38 Black/African American residents identify as mixed-race
- 2.5% (1 resident) identifies as white
- 2.5% (1 resident) declined to report
