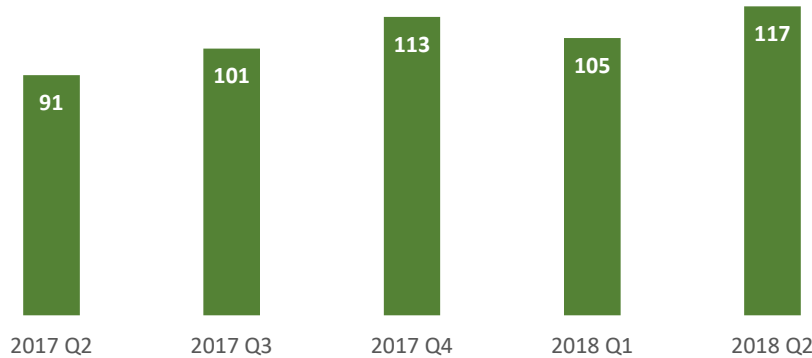

Second Quarter Community Complaints Data

**Preliminary Count of Community Complaints
Q2 2017 - Q2 2018**

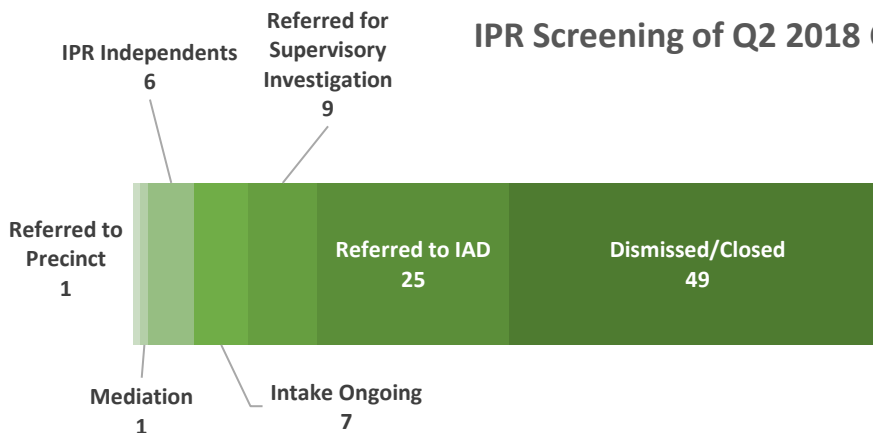


IPR and Internal Affairs received 117 community complaints during April, May, and June of 2018. This was 12 more than last quarter and 26 more complaints than the second quarter of 2017.

Ninety-eight of the complaints were received by IPR and nineteen came

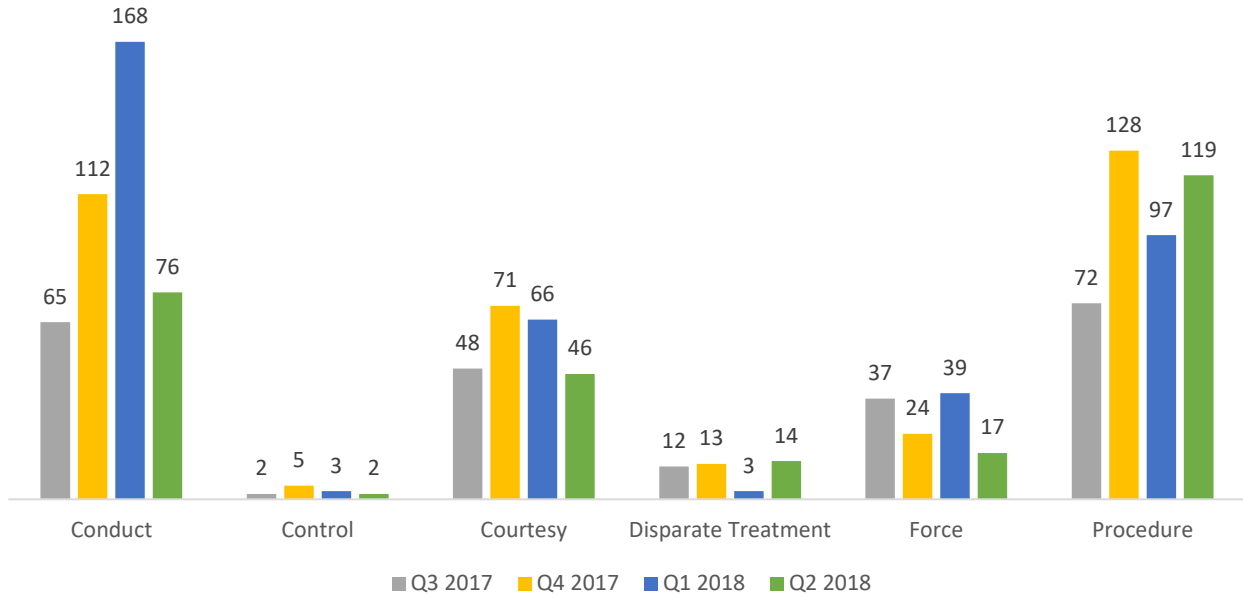
through Internal Affairs. Of the IPR complaints, nine were opened by IPR as independent investigations, twenty-five were referred to Internal Affairs and intake is ongoing for seven complaints. Forty-nine complaints were dismissed or administratively closed, most commonly because no misconduct was identified. Nine complaints were referred to officers' supervisors for investigation, one was referred to a precinct commander for follow-up and one complaint entered mediation.

IPR Screening of Q2 2018 Cases



Though many cases are still in progress and additional allegations will likely be added, community complaints made in the second quarter of 2018 contained 281 allegations.

Preliminary Count of Community Allegations by Category



Findings were completed for 141 allegations (from 36 cases) in the second quarter of 2018. Thirteen percent (19) of those allegations were sustained.
