Independent Police Review (IPR) Work Plan / Accomplishments

IPR Operations During COVID

Due to the ongoing public health crisis, all IPR staff are working remotely. Although the IPR office is closed to in-person visits, investigators are available to accept complaints online, by phone or by mail.

Staff Training

All Auditors Office staff, including IPR, began a multi-session Racial Equity Results Based Accountability training to improve the Auditor's Office's organizational culture and services and to ensure staff deliver racially equitable results to community members.

Community Outreach

IPR Senior Outreach Coordinator Irene Konev connected with staff of Immigrant and Refugee Community Organization, Latino Network and African and Youth Community Organization. Along with other IPR staff Konev attended the Interfaith Peace and Action Collaborative and Community Peace Collaborative meetings.

The OIR Group presented their most recent report on Officer Involved Shootings to City Council on September 30. IPAC will host the OIR group for a public meeting to discuss the report on November 6 from 9-10:30.
