Independent Police Review (IPR) Work Plan / Accomplishments

IPR Operations During COVID

Due to the ongoing public health crisis, all IPR staff are working remotely. Although the IPR office is closed to in-person visits, investigators are available to accept complaints online, by phone or by mail.

Staff Training

All Auditors Office staff, including IPR, began a multi-session Racial Equity Results Based Accountability training to improve the Auditor's Office's organizational culture and services and to ensure staff deliver racially equitable results to community members.

Community Outreach

IPR Senior Outreach Coordinator Irene Konev attended the Slavic Advisory Council meeting, the Community Peace Collaborative meeting and connected with community at the first virtual Say Hey Northwest networking event.

CRC Recruitment

The 2020 CRC recruitment moves forward and over 20 applicants are in the process of being selected by the CRC members, IPR staff and the community. IPR will announce new CRC members after the selection and training is completed in February 2020.
