#### **Independent Police Review (IPR) Work Plan / Accomplishments**

#### **IPR Operations During COVID**

Due to the ongoing public health crisis, all IPR staff are working remotely. Although the IPR office is closed to in-person visits, investigators are available to accept complaints online, by phone or by mail. City staff is currently expected to return to the office in October.

#### **IPR Annual Report**

#### **Community Outreach**

Senior Community Outreach Coordinator Irene Konev attended the Inter-faith Peace and Action Collaborative Meeting and the National Tribal Climate Change Summit – Traditional Knowledges and Tribal Sovereignty.

#### **Equity Training**

IPR staff continues equity and results-based accountability trainings along with colleagues in the Auditor's office.

#### **Settlement Agreement**

The City and DOJ had a meeting July 13<sup>th</sup>. During that meeting, the DOJ presented nine remedies to help bring the City back into compliance with the Settlement Agreement. Work continues on reaching an agreement for next steps, and mediation will likely be the next step. There next hearing scheduled with Judge Simon is August 24<sup>th</sup>.
