SUBJECT:	October 14, 2024, LGBTQ+ Historic Sites Project Briefing

On October 14, 2024, the HLC will receive a briefing from BPS regarding the completion of the multiyear LGBTQ+ Historic Sites Project. The LGBTQ+ Historic Sites Project was launched in 2022 using funding from the National Park Service, State Historic Preservation Office, and Portland City Council. The project has resulted in three National Register nominations, a 90-property historic resource survey, and a citywide historic context statement for LGBTQ+ history during the 1905-1994 period. The briefing will include a summary of project deliverables followed by commission questions and discussion.
