ORDINANCE NO.7321.

An Ordinance to amend the Title and to substitute certain other Sections in lieu of Sections 1,5,5,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,12 and 13 of Ordinance No.1410, entitled, "An Ordinance defining the duties, powers and compensation of the officers constituting the Street Department.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows;

Section 1; - That the Title of Ordinance No.1410 entitled "An Ordinance defining the duties, powers and compensation of the officers constituting the Street Department." be and the same is hereby abended as to read as follows;

An Ordinance defining the duties of the Surveyor and fixing his bond and compensation.

Section 2; - That said Ordinance No.1410 be further swended by striking out all of Sections 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10

12 and 13 and that there be and is hereby substituting in lim of the Sections so stricken out certain other Sections designated Sections 1,2,0,4,5 and 6 and to read respectively as follows;

Section 1;- It shall be the duty of the Surveyor in addition to the duties prescribed by the Charter to make all surveys for street extensions, lines of streets, street and sewer estimates, sewers and all other surveys within the limits of the City including the boundary thereof, whenever ordered to do so by the Common Council, and to make all estimates, maps, plans and specifications for improvements directed.

to be made by any resolution or ordinance of the City of Port-

Section 2; - The Surveyor shall keep a record of all street and sewer estimates, sewers, street improvements and street extension surveys. He shall also keep records showing the position of all sewers and drains laid by the City and the position of all branches for connections therewith, and have the same arranged conveniently for reference by property owners or their agents, and also of all marks or permanent or temporary street monuments. He shall also keep a record of the official grades of the City and correct the same as changes are made therein.

Surveyor shall place upon all lines hereafter run with solar compass; transit or theodolite, temporary monuments or reference posts, with proper bearings and distances, and of as substantial quality as circumstances will admit, and not more than six hundred feet apart.

Section 4; - On or before the fifth day of January annually the Surveyor shall make a report in writing to the Common
the number of streets surveyed and the accounts of the several
Council showing kinds of improvements of streets made during
the preceeding year and whether under authority of permits
or special Ordinances.

Section 5; - The salary of the Surveyor shall be twenty four hundred dollars per annum, payable monthly in the manner provided by Ordinance No. 1414 as amended.

Section 6; - The Surveyor, before entering upon the du-

land in the sum of two thousand dollars, payable in United
States gold or silver coin, with sufficient sureties, to be
approved by the Mayor, conditioned that he will well and
faithfully perform the duties of his office as Surveyor. The
parties who are sureties upon the Bond of the Surveyor shall
be required to file with the bond, affidavits to the effect
that they are worth in the aggregate over and above all debts
and liabilities and exclusive of property exempt from execution at least double the amount of the penal bond.
