### Why am I receiving this notice?

You are receiving this notice because you responded in writing to the matter, testified at a previous related hearing, or have requested notice of this hearing.

#### What is this project about?

The Better Housing by Design Recommended Draft includes proposals for Portland's multi-dwelling zones (primarily R3, R2, R1 and RH) that:

- Provide a new set of zones (RM1-RM4) that regulate development intensity by building size instead of unit density, providing more flexibility for the numbers and types of units.
- Expand development bonuses for projects that include affordable units.
- Allow limited amounts of ground-floor commercial uses along major corridors.
- Address needs for residential outdoor space and make parking optional in more situations.
- · Limit front garages and front parking.
- Provide standards specific to East Portland to promote better site design and new street connections.
- Change Zoning Map and zoning regulations for higher density zones in historic districts to address development scale issues, while providing incentives for affordable housing units.
