

Ordinance No. 24245

An Ordinance granting a revocable permit to the People's Amusement Company to erect an electric illuminated sign across Alder Street from the northwest corner of West Park Street to the southeast corner of West Park Street, in front of lots 3 and 4, block 216, Portland.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the People's Amusement Company be and is hereby granted a revocable permit to construct an electric illuminated sign across Alder Street from the northwest corner of West Park Street to the southeast corner of West Park Street, in front of lots 3 and 4, block 216, Portland. Said sign to be twenty-five feet long, thirty-six inches wide and six inches thick, and to be constructed in a manner satisfactory to the City Engineer, and be removed when so ordered by the Council.

Section 2. Said People's Amusement Company shall be required to furnish a bond, to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Portland, in the sum of two hundred fifty dollars, (\$250.00), conditioned that the provisions of this ordinance will be complied with in all respects.
