

ORDINANCE NO. 6029.


An Ordinance to amend Section 9 of Ordinance 5925 entitled
"An Ordinance to prevent certain animals from running at large
and providing for the impounding and sale of the same and the
appointment of a poundmaster and fixing his compensation.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows;

Section 1;- That Section 9 of Ordinance No. 5925 of the City
of Portland entitled "An Ordinance to prevent certain animals
from running at large and providing for the impounding and sale
of the same and the appointment of a poundmaster and fixing
his compensation" approved, September 23rd 1889, be and the same
is so amended as to read as follows;

+ Sec. 9;- The Poundmaster beside the cost of keeping adver-
tising and selling such animals taken up under the provisions
of this Ordinance shall tax, collect and pay into the City
Treasury as fees for taking up the same before the same is
taken from his custody the sum of Two Dollars and Fifty cents each
for cows, horses and mules, one dollar each for sheep, swine and
goats, and twenty five cents each for fowls. X
