The Model Cities Citizens' Planning Board approved budget allocations for programs at their meeting on Wednesday, January 2, 1974. It is the decision of the Board that Model Cities funds not be allocated for Pre-School Expansion for fiscal year 1974-75.

The School District funded 50% of the cost for the program during the Third Action Year Extension. It is anticipated that the School District will pick up the total cost for the year 1974-75 (\$26,074).
