With regret, the Scholarship Office is writing to officially notify you that your scholarship for Fall Term 1974 has been cancelled.


The reason for this cancellation is basically as follows; the Scholarship Office Budget for 1974-75 Academic Year has been cut by the Model Cities Citizens Planning Board and adopted by the Portland City Council on Wednesday, September 25, 1974.

The Scholarship Office realizes the unfortunate position that our cancellation of your scholarship has put you in, and can only hope that you can successfully obtain other financial assistance to enroll in school this Fall Term 1974.

As things stand right now, the Scholarship Office has been cut from sixty-five (65) scholarships to fifty-four (54), a total of \$9,025.

Again, please accept my apology for this situation and if there is anything that we can assist you with in getting into school this fall, please call us at once.

At the July 16, 1974, meeting of the Citizens Planning Board, the policy Board for the Model Cities' Agency, allocated a \$35,000 funding grant for the Fifth Action Year (5AY). At that time the Executive Director of the Martin Luther King Program requested an additional \$9,025, supplement to the approved budget.

At that time the Citizens Planning Board officially moved to hold the request for the supplemental money in abeyance until a conclusive decision could be made relative to the total surplus of \$26,012.

A meeting was held July 30, 1974, at Bethel A.M.E. Church to discuss, primarily, the Model Cities' Transition Plan to be submitted to City Council. After the meeting adjourned a second meeting evolved to discuss the surplus budget amount of \$26,012. At that time the Committee arrived at a decision to allow Martin Luther King to receive \$9,025 of the surplus amount. As a result of this action the Martin Luther King Board and its Executive Director implemented budgetary steps which encompassed the supplemental amount requested.


On August 27, 1974, in accordance with the Citizens Planning Board's By-Laws, Rules, and Regulations, the validity of the meeting on July 30, 1974, was contested and ruled to be an invalid meeting.

Therefore, the total allocation of the surplus dollars, \$26,012, was declared to be an invalid allocation. Concurrently on-going were the union contractual negotiations for city employees. As a result of the negotiations a salary increase of 10.4%, cost

of living adjustment, was also mandatory within the Model Cities' Administrative budget for employees. The total amount needed was \$26,000, to cover the administrative cost, thus eliminating the surplus dollars of \$26,012, which included the request held in abeyance for the Martin Luther King Program.

I strongly suggest that you, as Chairman of the Board and/or the Executive Director, consult with the Model Cities Director and/or the Chairman of the Citizens Planning Board, to discuss future alternatives.


Listed on the accompanying pages are the names of the students and the institutions of higher education each is attending.
