



Roles of Council and Mayor

Future role of legislative council

Future role of executive mayor

Manages city services with the help of the city administrator.

Set policy.

Makes appropriations, raises revenue and adopts the City's budget.

Convenes public meetings, gathers input, debates and evaluates policy choices, and adopts laws or policies to reflect those choices.

Quasi-judicial power to apply laws and policies.

Adopts administrative rules and executes laws.

Administers bureaus, employees, facilities and resources. Ensures the City is using appropriated funds effectively.

Introduces matters before council with the same authority as a councilor, and votes in the case of a tie.


Reason you want to engage

I may be able to use my lived experiences to improve a program that is important to me, or help a bureau improve their service.


Options for ways to engage


- Participate in city-hosted meetings, events and surveys.

- Call or provide written input to mayor's office.






Preparing for Mayor-Council Government






A different reporting structure gives a city administrator the best chance to successfully lead and sets the stage for future improvements that benefit community and employees.

- The Auditor is independent of City Council and accountable only to the public.
- The City Auditor's Office promotes open and accountable government by providing independent and impartial reviews, access to public information, and services for City government and the public.
- The position has been elected by voters since 1891.
