

## ORDINANCE No. 134431

An Ordinance ratifying the action of the Commissioner of Public Safety in sending Opal Strong, Citizens Planning Board member, to discuss Model Cities programs in Richmond and Oakland, California, April 24-26, 1972, authorizing a warrant for \$150, providing for an accounting, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that the Commissioner in charge of the Model Cities Program directed Opal Strong, Citizens Planning Board member, to travel to Richmond and Oakland, California, April 24-26, 1972, to discuss Model Cities programs; and that the action of the Commissioner should be ratified; now, therefore, the action of the Commissioner of Public Safety in sending Opal Strong to Richmond and Oakland, California, April 24-26, 1972, to discuss Model Cities programs is hereby ratified and approved. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw a warrant for \$150 in favor of Opal Strong for expenses incurred. Said warrant shall be charged to the Model Cities Fund appropriation Citizens Participation Division, Travel and Transportation (6682.310). Opal Strong shall file with the Auditor an accounting of actual expenses together with available receipts and any remaining balance shall be deposited with the Treasurer and credited to the above appropriation.


Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that there may be no unnecessary delay in ratifying the action of the Commissioner of Public Safety in sending Opal Strong to Richmond and Oakland, California, April 24-26, 1972; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
