## ORDINANCE No. 134781

An Ordinance granting a leave of absence without pay to Carolyn B. Easterly, Employee No. 17018, Portland Model Cities, Dept. of Public Safety, for the period commencing June 26, 1972 through August 7, 1972, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that Carolyn B. Easterly, Employee No. 17018, Portland Model Cities, Dept. of Public Safety, has heretofore filed a request under oath for a leave of absence without pay pursuant to Sections 4.24.020 and 4.24.030 of the Code of the City of Portland, Oregon, beginning on June 26, 1972 through August 7, 1972, which request is supported by a statement from the physician, E. M. DeCastro, M. D., 1114 Portland Medical Center, 511 S. W. 10th Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97205; that her leave without pay has been approved by the Executive Director of Model Cities and the Commissioner in charge of Model Cities, and, therefore, should be approved; now, therefore, a leave of absence without pay is hereby granted to Carolyn B.
