ORDINANCE No. 130288

An Ordinance authorizing and directing Acting Director Kenneth Hampton and Edward Warmoth, Model Cities Coordinator, to attend a City Demonstration Agency Director's meeting in San Diego January 20-22, 1970, authorizing expenditure in the sum of \$422, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that a meeting of City Demonstration Agency directors is scheduled to be held in San Diego January 20, 21 and 22, 1970; that it is in the public interest of the City for Kenneth Hampton, Acting Director of the Model Cities Program, and Edward Warmoth, Model Cities Coordinator, attend; that expenses in the sum of \$211 for each should be allowed; now, therefore, Kenneth Hampton, Acting Director of the Model Cities Program, and Edward Warmoth, Model Cities Coordinator, hereby are authorized and directed to attend the City Demonstration Agency Directors' meeting in San Diego, California, January 20, 21 and 22, 1970, and the Mayor and Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver a warrant in the sum of \$211, payable to Kenneth Hampton and a warrant in the sum of \$211, payable to Edward Warmouth, as advance for expenses. The warrants herein authorized shall be charged as follows: Kenneth Hampton, Model Cities Administration, Travel and Transportation (6683.310), and Mr. Warmoth, charged to the General Fund appropriation Travel and Employe Eduucation (4835). Each employe shall file an accounting with the City Auditor of actual expenses, together with available receipts, and any remaining balance shall be deposited with the Treasurer credited to the above appropriation.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that necessary arrangements may be made for the scheduled meeting; therefore an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
