ORDINANCE No. 130866

An Ordinance ratifying the action of the Commissioner of Finance and Administration in sending Ed Warmoth, Model Cities Coordinator, to San Francisco, California, April 27-28, 1970 to deliver the revised Pre-NDP (Neighborhood Development Program) proposal to the Department of Housing and Urban Development, authorizing a warrant for \$105 for expenses incurred, providing for an accounting, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:


Section 1. The Council finds that it was necessary to deliver the revised Pre-NDP Proposal for the Model Cities program to the San Francisco office of HUD; that the Commissioner of Finance and Administration directed Ed Warmoth to deliver and explain the proposal; that this action should now be ratified and that funds for actual expenses of \$105 should be provided; now, therefore, the action of the Commissioner of Finance and Administration in sending Ed Warmoth to San Francisco, California, April 27-28, 1970, for the purpose described above is hereby ratified and approved. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw a warrant for \$105 in favor of Ed Warmoth for expenses incurred on the trip to San Francisco. Said warrant shall be charged to Model Cities Fund, Model Cities Administration, Travel and Transportation (6683.310). Ed Warmoth shall file with the Auditor an accounting of his expenses.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that there may be no unnecessary delay in ratifying the action of the Commissioner of Finance and Administration in sending Ed Warmoth to San Francisco, California, April 27-28, 1970; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
