ORDINANCE No. 130898

An Ordinance granting a leave of absence without pay to JoAnn St. John, employe Model Cities, for a period of time from July 1, 1970 to November 30, 1970, under the provisions of the Code of the City, Ordinance No. 130672, Title 4, Section 4.24.050, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that JoAnn St. John, employes Model Cities, has filed a request for a leave of absence without pay under Section 4.24.050 of Title 4, of Ordinance No. 130672, Code of the City of Portland, to become effective July 1, 1970 and ending November 30, 1970, which request is supported by a statement under oath from her physician Richard N. Bolton, M.D., 2220 Lloyd Center, Portland, Oregon 97232; that said request has been approved by her supervisor J. Alton Page, Acting Director Model Cities, and by the Commissioner in charge, Mayor Schrunk and should be granted; now, therefore, JoAnn St. John, employe Model Cities, hereby is granted a leave of absence without pay for a period commencing July 1, 1970 and ending November 30, 1970, pursuant to the provisions of Section 4.24.050 of Title 4 of Ordinance No. 130672, the Code of the City of Portland. Said employe shall not be permitted to return to City employment until 30 days have elapsed after the end of the period of pregnancy, and she shall have filed with the City Auditor a statement from her physician to the effect that said physician approves her resuming her duties with the Model Cities.


Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that there may be no delay in granting the leave set forth in Section 1 hereof; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
