" Ordinance N^o 13 "

That Ordinance, authorizing the purchase of one Fire engine, with Hose Carriage, and Hose for the same, and for Carriage for Hook and Ladder Co.

Section 1st — The people of the City of Portland do ordain as follows: — That the Committee on fire department with the Mayor, be, and they are hereby authorized, to purchase one Fire Engine, with one Hose Carriage together with a sufficient quantity of Hose for the same, at a cost not exceeding Two Thousand Dollars.

Section 2nd — That the Committee on Fire Department with the Mayor, be, and they are hereby authorized to purchase a Carriage for the Vigilance Hook & Ladder Company at a cost not exceeding two hundred Dollars.

Section 3rd — This ordinance to take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
