

"Ordinance No 14"

An Ordinance providing for the election of a City Attorney defining his duties &c.

Section 1st — The people of the City of Portland do ordain as follows, That there be elected annually by the Common Council a City Attorney, who shall hold his office for one year, and until his successor be elected and qualified.

Section 2nd — It shall be the duty of the City Attorney before entering upon the duties of his office, to take an oath, or affirmation to faithfully discharge the duties thereof, as provided in section seven article six of the City Charter, and such other duties as may be hereafter prescribed by ordinance.

Section 3rd — That the City Attorney receive for his services such Compensation as may be hereafter, allowed by the Common Council, Such Compensation to be allowed quarterly.

Section 4th — This ordinance to take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
