

The Ordinance to authorize must require the planing of a part of Front Street.

The people of the City of Portland do ordain as follows.

Sec 1st That the owners of all lots in the city of Portland, situate adjacent to and immediately West of Front Street, in Blocks No. 1, 2, 3, 4, 26, 27, 39, & 40, according to the Plot of said city, are required, at their own expense, on or before the first day of October next ensuing, to grade and plank ^{or timber} 30 feet in width of Front Street, west East of their respective lots, said grading and planing to consist of a side walk 9 feet in width, on the West side of said street, and the remaining 21 feet to be a substantial plank ^{or timber} road for waggons.

Sec 2^d That all plank ^{or timber} used in planing said street shall equal or exceed 3 inches in thickness, (shall have square edges) and all plank used for the construction of side walks, shall equal or exceed 2 inches in thickness, (shall not exceed 6 inches in width and shall have square edges, provided that nothing in the first two sections of this ordinance shall be so construed as to prevent any lot holder from laying a good and substantial brick side walk in front of his property)

Sec 3^d That ^{all of} said ^{work} planing ^{shall} be done in accordance with the established grade of said street, and under the direction and supervision of the Street Commissioners of that city

Sec 4th That said Street Commissioner, with
the aid of the city Surveyor, is empowered
to prepare a plan for planking said street,
for constructing the side walks, gutters and
sewers, and present the same to the city
Council, and if approved by them, to
direct and superintend the execution of
the same in accordance therewith.

Sec 5th That said Street Commissioner is
authorized to plank ^{or timber} the crossings on
said portion of Front street at the expense
of the city of Pittsburg

Sec 6th That said Street Commissioner is re-
quired, (with the advice and cooperation
together with
of the Committee on Streets, Public Buildings
and Improvements) to advertise for bids
for furnishing plank and timber, requisite
for ^{timbering} planking the crossings, and to contract for
the purchase of the same with the lowest
(reasonable) bidder.

Sec 8th That this ordinance shall take effect
and be in force ^{within fifteen days} after its approval
by the Mayor.

Ordinance No 17

An Ordinance to authorize and require the planking of a part of Front Street.

The people of the City of Portland do ordain as follows.

Section 1st That the owners of all lots in the City of Portland, situate and adjacent to and immediately west of Front Street, in Blocks No 1, 2, 3, 4, 26, 27, 39 & 40, according to the Plat of said City, are required at their own expense, on or before the first day of October next ensuing, to grade and plank or timber thirty feet in width of Front Street next each of their respective lots, said grading and planking to consist of a side walk nine feet in width, on the west side of said street and the remaining twenty one feet to be a substantial plank or timber road for waggons.

Section 2nd— That all plank or timber used in planking said street shall equal or exceed three inches in thickness, and shall have square edges, and all plank used for the construction of side walks, shall equal or exceed two inches in thickness, shall not exceed six inches in thickness width and shall have square edges. Provided that nothing in the first two sections of this ordinance shall be so construed as to prevent any lot holder from laying a good and substantial brick side walk in front of his property.

Section 3rd— That all of said work shall be done in accordance with the established grade of said street, and under the direction and supervision of the Street Commissioner of the City.

Section 4th— That said Street Commissioner, with the aid of the City Surveyor, is empowered and required to prepare a plan for planking said street, for constructing the said walks.

gutters, and sewers, and present the same to the City Council, and if approved by them the Street Commissioner shall direct and superintend the execution of the same in accordance therewith.

Section 5th:— That said Street Commissioner is authorized to plank or timber the Crossings on said portion of Front Street at the Expense of the City of Portland.

Section 6th:— That said Street Commissioner is required together with the Committee on Streets Public Buildings and Improvements, to advertise for bids for Planking or timbering the Crossings, and to contract for the same with the lowest responsible bidder.

Section 7th:— That the Contractor or Contractors shall be required to give security to the City for the faithful performance of his or their Contract in the sum of \$2000.00, said security to be approved by the Committee on Streets Public Buildings and Improvements.

Section 8th:— That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force within fifteen days after its approval by the Mayor.
