"An Ordinance fixing the Compensation of
City Assessor."

Sect 1st — The people of the City of Portland do
ordain as follows: That the assessor be and he is
hereby allowed a compensation of \$5.00 per
day for each and every day actually employed
by him in the discharge of the duties of his
Office

Sect 2nd — The assessor shall make out a
bill for the number of days employed in the dis-
- charge of the duties of his office, at the rate provi-
- ded in section one of this Ordinance, the bill

before the recorder.

Sect 3rd — This Ordinance shall take
effect and be in force from and after its
approval by the Mayor.
