An Ordinance to establish and locate a
ferry landing in the City of Portland.

Sect 1st — The people of the City of Portland
do ordain as follows: — That a ferry landing be
and is hereby established and located at the foot
of Stark Street, and the ferry boat shall have
the right to come and depart from her landing
without hindrance or obstruction from any vessel
raft or craft, and the owner or owners of such
ferry boat shall have the right to make any
improvements that may be necessary to per-
fect a good and sufficient landing provided nothing
in this section shall be construed as giving the
right to cut or destroy any part of Stark
Street, west of the east line of front street,

Sect 2nd — No one ferry owner or
owners shall have the use of more than one
landing.

Sect 3rd — This ordinance shall
take effect and be in force from and after its
approval by the Mayor

An ordinance to Establish and locate a Ferry Landing in the City of Portland —

The people of the City of Portland do ordain as follows. That a ferry landing be and is hereby established and located at the foot of Stark Street, and the ferry boat shall have the right to come and depart from the her landing without hindrance or obstruction from any vessel raft or craft, and the owner or owners of such ferry boat shall have the right to make any improvements that may be necessary to perfect a good and sufficient landing, provided nothing in this section shall be construed as giving the right to cut or destroy any part of Stark Street west of the east line of Front Street.

Sec 2 — No one ferry owner or owners shall have the use of more than one landing. —

Sec 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the mayor.
