An ordinance to ^{regulate} provide for the
storage of Gun Powder -

The people of the city of Portland do
ordain as follows

Sect 1 That it shall not be lawful for
any person or persons to keep for their
private use in any one house or place
within the limits of the city of Portland,
more than five pounds of Powder at
any one time, under the penalty of not
less than twenty five dollars, nor more
than one hundred dollars, at the discretion
of the Recorder for each and every offence -

Sect 2 That it shall not be lawful for
any person or persons to keep in any one
store, building or other place within the
following limits of said city, viz,
commencing at the North east corner of
said city, thence west to tenth street,
thence southerly on the eastern side
of tenth street to the southern boundary
of said city, thence east along the southern
line of said city to the South east corner
of said city, thence northerly along the
eastern boundary of said city to the
place of beginning, ~~more than twenty~~

More than Twenty five pounds of powder at any one time; and that shall be kept in a box, well secured with the word "Powder" distinctly marked upon it. The said box shall always be kept within six feet of the main entrance of the building or place where powder is kept. It shall be the duty of every person keeping powder as aforesaid to keep in a conspicuous place on the front of the building or place in which such powder is kept a sign with the words "Powder ~~for~~ for Sale" conspicuously painted upon it. And any person violating any of the provisions of this section shall be fined not less than fifty dollars nor more than one hundred dollars for each and every offence at the discretion of the Recorder

Ordinance No 34.

An Ordinance to provide for the storage of gunpowder.

Sec. 1. The People of the City of Portland do ordain as follows: That it shall not be lawful for any person or persons to keep for their private use in any one house or place within the limits of this city of Portland, more than five pounds of powder at any one time, under the penalty of not less than twenty five dollars, nor more than one hundred dollars, at the discretion of the recorder, for each and every offence.

Sec. 2. That it shall not be lawful for any person or persons to keep in any one store, building, or other place within the following limits of said city viz; Commencing at the North East corner of said city. thence West to Tenth Street, thence Southward on the Easterly side of Tenth Street, to the Southern boundary of said City; thence East along the South line of said City to the South East corner of said city; thence Northward along the Eastern boundary of said City to the place of beginning, more than twenty five pounds of powder at any one time, and that shall be kept, in a box well secured, with the words, "Powder" distinctly marked upon it; the said box shall always be kept within six feet of the main entrance of the building or place where powder is kept. It shall be the duty of every person keeping powder as aforesaid to keep in

a conspicuous place on the front of the building
or place in which such powder is kept a sign
with the words "Powder for Sale"; Conspicuously
painted upon it; and any person violating any
of the provisions of this section shall be fined
not less than fifty dollars nor more than
one hundred dollars, for each and every
offence at the discretion of the Recorder.

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An ordinance to provide for the Storage of Gun powder

The people of the City of Portland do ordain as follows That it shall not be lawful for any person or persons to keep for their private use in any one house or place within the limits of this City more than five pounds of powder at any one time, under the penalty of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$10.00 at the discretion of the recorder for each and every offence

Sec 2 That it shall not be lawful for any person or persons to keep in any one store building or other place within the limits of the City more than 25 pounds of powder at any one time, and that shall be kept in a strong iron or copper chest well secured and fastened with the word powder distinctly painted upon it. the said chest shall always be kept within six feet of the main entrance of the building or place where powder is kept, it shall be the duty of every person keeping powder as aforesaid, to keep in

a sign was placed on

the words "Powder for sale" conspicuously
painted upon it, and any person violating
any of the provisions of this section shall
be fined not less than \$50.00 nor more
than \$100.00 at the discretion of the
recorder for each and every offense
