Context

- Historic budget crisis
- \$93 million gap
- Deep cuts
- PCEF dollars used to balance the budget in recent years and currently (Bureau allocations, interest)





The Proposal

- Loan from PCEF's contingency balance to the General Fund
- Does not impact approved PCEF spending (CIP)
- Loan amount should be minimal,

used as last resort



How It Works

- Borrows against fund while in surplus
- Does not impactprogram delivery
