Dear Doctor:

The committee appointed to arrange plans for our school inspection met last night at Dr. Ellis's office, and adopted the following general rules:-

The health wardens are to begin work Monday, October 14th, and to make weekly inspections until the closing of the schools next June. They are to confer with the Principals and arrange a time mutually convenient.

The inspection is to be general, and it is the opinion of the committee that the most good can be accomplished by co-operating with the teachers; for this reason a card of instructions will be sent to each teacher, and in cases where the teacher is in doubt as to the advisability of sending a child home, it will be his or her duty to confer with the health warden of the school.

A report of all exclusions and the disease for which they are made should be sent to the Health Department monthly. Also a report on the sanitary conditions of the schools, and any recommendations that may be conducive to the development and general well being of the public school children.
