| Code Modification or Alternate<br>Requested | Owner proposes to use an 'air admittance valve' at the exterior sink in lieu of a vent.  |
| Proposed Design                             | The project has a sink at the exterior amenity deck adjacent to the BBQ grills on L3. Because this BBQ area is outside, there are no walls to run the vents thru. The team determined that the constructability issue could be resolved by using an 'air admittance valve in accordance with the requirements of the stat-approved use of this device. |
| Reason for alternative                      | Previous designs had a wall adjacent to the grill. The wall and trellis were removed for VE purposes. Since the wall was removed, there is no viable option for locating a vent.   |
|   | According to the contractor, the inspector, Paul Klee, supports this appeal for this location. Reference previous appeals 11560, 16988 & 18116.  |

## **APPEAL DECISION**

## Granted as proposed.

"The Administrative Appeal Board finds that the information submitted by the appellant demonstrates that the approved modifications or alternate methods are consistent with the intent of the code; do not lessen health, safety, accessibility, life, fire safety or structural requirements; and that special conditions unique to this project make strict application of those code sections impractical.
