## ORDINANCE NO. 165017

\*Authorize application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for an Emergency Shelter Grant under Title IV of the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Assistance Act of 1987 in the amount of \$207,000. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- Title IV of the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Assistance Act 1. of 1987 [P.L. 100-71, 416(b)] authorizes entitlement grants to cities under the Emergency Shelter Grant Program.
- Grant funds may be used for rehabilitation of emergency 2. shelter facilities, payment of shelter facility operating costs, essential client services, and homeless prevention activities.
- Grant funds under the Emergency Shelter Grant Program can be 3. used to address needs identified by the Funders Advisory Committee.
- It is appropriate and in the public interest that the Mayor 4. be authorized to apply for such a grant.
- NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:
- The Mayor is authorized to apply to the U.S. Department of a. Housing and Urban Development on behalf of the City of Portland for an Emergency Shelter Grant in the amount of \$207,000.
- The Mayor is authorized to provide such assurances and b. information to the Department of Housing and Urban Development as may be required for application and orderly management of the grant.

Section 2. So that there will be no delay in providing emergency shelter for the homeless, the Council declares that an emergency exists and this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
