An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to call for bids to furnish materials and labor for construction of the Southeast Relieving Interceptor, Phase 3, for the Bureau of Environmental Services; authorizing a contract, subject to Environmental Protection Agency approval; authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Construction of the Southeast Relieving Inteceptor is needed to alleviate the overloaded condition of the existing interceptor and to provide for anticipated growth within the existing service area.
- 2. Phase 3 is an integral part of the Southeast Relieving Interceptor and will run from SE 11th and Main to SE 21st and Bush.
- 3. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has awarded the City a grant for construction of Phase 3.
- 4. The Bureau of Environmental Services requires the furnishing of materials and labor for the construction of the Southeast Relieving Interceptor, Phase 3.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent shall advertise for bids using plans and specifications filed in his office.
- b. The Commissioner of Public Utilities and the Auditor are authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder, subject to Environmental Protection Agency approval, for the project described in Section 1 hereof, in accordance with the plans and specifications filed with the Purchasing Agent.
- c. The Mayor and the Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the 1986-87 Sewage Construction Fund budget, when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with this project could delay completion of the project on schedule; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
